

# SAND MOOR GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

## 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- (a) Beyond the line of any boundary fence or hedge.
- (b) The Club House, the car park, and beyond the white line down the side of the drive nearest to the putting green.
- (c) Beyond the line of white posts along the left hand side of the 1st and 18th holes, and the right hand side of the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th holes.

## 2. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

## 3. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

The bridle path crossing the 8th, 16th and 18th holes is deemed to be an integral part of the course. The ball must be played as it lies or relief taken under penalty (Rule 28 Ball Unplayable).

## 4. PATHS

The paths surfaced with crushed slate or wood chip are considered to be an 'Obstruction' under the rules of golf. Under Rule 24-2b a player may take relief by lifting the ball and dropping it without penalty within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief.

## 5. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS & DISTANCE MARKERS

All fixed sprinkler heads and distance markers are Immovable Obstructions and Rule 24-2 applies. In addition, if such an obstruction is on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows:

If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is

within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay, which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

## 6. PRACTICE (Rule 7)

On the day of a stroke competition, a player shall not practice on the course, except that a player may practice putting only on the practice putting green.

## NOTICES

1. Please replace divots, smooth out bunkers, repair pitch marks on greens and do not take trolleys on to tees or the aprons of the greens.
2. Players must inform the Secretary of any damage to any property, in particular broken windows in houses adjacent to the course.
3. Players must under no circumstances enter property adjoining the course to retrieve golf balls, without permission.
4. Players are required to observe caution when playing over the public rights of way across the 8th, 16th and 18th holes.
5. Players should wear golf shoes with studs appropriate for the prevailing weather and ground conditions. Particular care is urged on grassy slopes. Designated paths and steps should be used where available.
6. Please use the warning bells located after the 3rd green, along the 4th & 12th fairways and after the 18th green.
